ARC Feral Cat Neuter "Pilot" Program

The Galveston County Animal Resource Center (ARC) experiences daily consequences of pets not being sterilized by receiving thousands of unwanted pets a year. To help combat the pet overpopulation problem, the ARC is now offering feral feline neuter services to the public.

We understand the challenges of finding surgery appointment availability and finding affordable options. We have the upmost respect for the citizens who are devoting their personal time, finances, and lives to helping the Galveston County community cats. We want to help!

How It Works:

Step 1: Fill out the application online or in person

Step 2: ARC Staff will review the form and contact you regarding a surgery date

Step 3: You will drop off the feral male cat, in a humane trap, to the ARC by 10 am on specified surgery date.

Step 4: Each feral male cat will receive a neuter, rabies vaccine, antibiotic, pain medication and ear tip for the package price. Additional services can be purchased.

Step 5: You can pick up your feral neutered male cat the same day at or around 4:30 pm.

Package Price = \$50

Includes: Feral Cat Neuter, Rabies Vaccine (Rabies certificate and tag), Antibiotic injection, Pain injection, and Ear Tip

Additional Services (Optional):

FVRCP = \$20 Microchip = \$20 Catego (Flea control) = \$9.60 (applied while sedated)

*Appointments are REQUIRED. We cannot guarantee veterinarian availability without an appointment.

*No female feral cats can be accepted, at this time.

ARC Public Feral Cat Neuter PILOT Program

Purpose:

The ARC would like to begin offering feral cat neuters to the public. Galveston County has a serious need for more availability to spay/neuter options. Since we are already neutering the ARC cats in house, we feel that we are ready for the next step. We would like to be able to help fill a gap in the need for more feral cat surgery appointments. Citizens dedicated to saving the lives of Galveston County cats have expressed concern about 1) not being able to get appointments, 2) not having enough traps and 3) funding. The ARC can help with offering appointments at a low cost.

The funds raised would go into the Clinic fund to help build the spay/neuter suite.

The neuters will be performed within the current veterinary contract, with current ARC staff. No additional resources are being requested, at this time.

The current in-house cat neuter cost at the ARC is \$2.72 (drugs and supplies). The current cost per rabies vaccine and tag is \$2.99. Therefore, the total cost incurred for each cat would be \$5.71.

PILOT Program: We are projecting to do a max of 5 feral cat neuters per week, within our current vet contract and staff structure. We will not overload ourselves to create issues for any other programs. We plan to assess the demand over the first 3-6 months.

*We are requesting that the Animal Services Advisory Committee approve of proceeding with this program and proposed fee pending final approval by the United Board of Health.


